His father Robert is a classical pianist and Professor Emeritus at Chico State University, and his mother plays the cello and performs as an international folk dancer. These influences have guided his musical journey toward the worlds of jazz, rock, classical, Balkan, and North Indian classical music.

Bryan toured the United States with RCA recording artists Behan/Johnson. He has also recorded and performed in the international music arena with such groups as Ivan Milev, Edessa, Trio Mopmu with Lily Storm, Late Gift, and Kitka.

Bryan studied music formally at The Berklee College of Music in Boston, CSU Long Beach, and CSU Chico. He is currently a free lance performer and composer in the San Francisco Bay Area.
